### Call for Applications for the Selection Process for Granting Master's Scholarships in the Graduate Program in Technological and Environmental Chemistry

The Coordination of the Graduate Program in Technological and Environmental Chemistry (PPGQTA) at FURG hereby announces the opening of applications for the selection process for the granting of **two (2) CAPES/Social Demand (DS) Master's scholarships**. The scholarships will be governed by the rules described below, and the selection process will be conducted by the PPGQTA Selection Committee.

#### I – PURPOSE

**Article 1<sup>st</sup>** - The purpose of this call for applications is the selection process for granting Master's scholarships to students regularly enrolled in the PPGQTA Program at the Federal University of Rio Grande (FURG) in the year 2025, in accordance with the CAPES Social Demand Program.

#### II – APPLICATIONS

**Article 2<sup>nd</sup>** - The applications referred to in this Call for Applications shall be submitted from November 17 to November 18, 2025 (until 12:00 PM), by delivering the documentation listed below to the Secretary's Office of the Graduate Program in Technological and Environmental Chemistry (PPGQTA) at the FURG Carreiros Campus, via the email address [ppgquimica@furg.br](mailto:ppgquimica@furg.br). The scholarships shall become effective starting from the month following the publication of the results of this Call.

**Article 3<sup>rd</sup>** - Mandatory documents for registration are:

- I - Application Form (**Annex I** of this Call for Applications)
- II - **CPF** (Individual Taxpayer Registry) and/or **Passport**

**Article 4<sup>th</sup>** - The conditions for the granting and maintenance of CAPES/DS scholarships require compliance with the [Rules for distribution and monitoring of scholarships in the PPGQTA](#), which, in turn, must be in accordance with CAPES Ordinance No. 76 of April 14, 2010, Ordinance No. 79 of April 28, 2023, and CAPES Ordinance No. 133 of July 2023.

#### III – SELECTION AND RESULTS

**Article 5<sup>th</sup>** - The Scholarship Committee will examine the candidates' documentation, and the final selection result will be published on the PPGQTA [homepage](#) on **November 18, 2025 (after 12:00 PM)**.

#### IV – SCHOLARSHIP DISTRIBUTION

**Article 6<sup>th</sup>** - The available CAPES/DS scholarships will be distributed according to the classification order established in **Call for Applications 11/2025**.

**Article 7<sup>th</sup>** - Of the total number of spots, **30% will be linked to the affirmative action policy**, in accordance with **Resolution No. 45/2024 from CONSUN/FURG** (available at: <https://conselhos.furg.br/resolucoes/resolucoes-2024/resolucoes-2024-45>) and **Normative Instruction IN PROPESP/FURG No. 6, of October 27, 2022** (available at: [https://prosp.furg.br/images/IN\\_PROPESP\\_6\\_2022\\_ProAAf-PG.pdf](https://prosp.furg.br/images/IN_PROPESP_6_2022_ProAAf-PG.pdf)). The spots will be filled

according to the **classification order** based on the criteria described in this call for applications. Candidates under the affirmative action policies will **compete for the spots concomitantly**. In the event a candidate is classified under the **broad competition (general category)**, admission will mandatorily occur through the broad competition, without prejudice to the mechanisms for their permanence. If the spots reserved for the affirmative action policy are not filled, they will automatically become available for the broad competition spots. The candidate approved for the spots linked to the affirmative action policy will undergo **verification by the self-declaration committee**.

#### IV - VALIDITY PERIOD AND OTHER PROVISIONS

**Article 8<sup>th</sup>** - The validity of this Call for Applications shall expire when the Program's next Selection Call is concluded.

**Article 9<sup>th</sup>** - The number of scholarships informed in this Call for Applications may be subject to modifications according to possible changes in the distribution of scholarships by CAPES.

**Article 10<sup>th</sup>** - Any cases not covered by these rules shall be resolved by the Coordination.
